

A MESSAGE FROM THE MARYLAND NURSE HONOR GUARD



Nurses in Maryland now are able to have a tribute from The Maryland Nurse Honor Guard at their memorial services. Similar to a military tribute, the Maryland Nurse Honor Guard's mission is to honor all nurses from Maryland who have passed away with a special ceremony to help provide comfort to their families, friends and colleagues.

Nurse Honor Guard members are nurse volunteers who wear a traditional nursing uniform of all white with a nursing cap and cape representative of the Army Nurse Cadet Corps from WWI. The nursing tribute is approximately 5 minutes long, and can be placed anywhere in the memorial service, and in any location where services are held. Tributes are non-denominational and consist of a reading, presenting a rose to the nurse to thank them for their service, a last call to duty, and the presentation of a Nightingale lamp to the family as a keepsake of their loved one's contribution to the profession of nursing.
